2 Vide ibid Public Notice at Sr.No. (3) above, it was ordered that all the shops in Deolali Cantt. limits will remain open from **09.00 am to 07.00 pm**.

3 It has been mentioned in ibid Order (Sr.No. (5) above) at Para-4 that depending upon the situation prevailing at the then period, for entire Nashik District the **timings** for opening of hotels (with sale of liquor)/bar from 11.00 am to 09.00 pm, (2) for hotels (without sale of liquor) from 08.00 am to 09.00 pm, (3) for Wine shops from 09.00 am to 07.00 pm, further (4) for other establishments from 07.00 am to 08.00 pm **was fixed**.

3 Now, the District Collector & District Magistrate, Nashik have issued Revised Order vide Sr.No. (5) above that considering the present situation, all orders issued earlier in this respect have been cancelled and for all Establishments in entire Nashik District an equal timing i.e. from <u>09.00 am to 09.00 pm</u> is being decided.

4 In view of the above, it is hereby ordered that all Establishments in entire Deolali Cantonment area will remain open from <u>09.00 am to 09.00 pm</u>.

5 The shopkeepers should ensure that they have erected **barricading** in front of their shops and have marked signs for maintaining **social distancing** in a proper way. They are also required to keep **sanitizer** for the use of customers and ensure **wearing of mask** by themselves, their servants and customers visiting their shops and institutions, referred above. Large public **gathering**/ congregations continue to remain **prohibited**. **Spitting in public places** will be **punishable** with **fine of Rs. 500**/-, in accordance with laws, rules or regulations. **Consumption of liquor, paan, tobacco** etc. in public places is prohibited.

It may be noted that if any shop is found open beyond the stipulated timing and violating the above terms and conditions, the following fine will be imposed upon the shopkeepers concerned.

(1) Shop found open:

Rs. 1000/- for 1st Offence Rs. 2000/- for 2nd Offence Rs. 3000/- for 3rd Offence Forceful closure for 4th Offence.

(2) For not maintaining Rs. 500/- for 1st offence required Social Distancing. Rs. 1000/- for subsequent offence.

It may also be noted that in case of failure to comply with the above directions, an appropriate legal action will be initiated against the persons concerned under the Disaster Management Act, 2005, Indian Epidemic Disease Act, 1897 other related Acts of the Government and Rules concerned.
